new & noteworthy

- **California headquarters:** California will require public companies headquartered in that state to include members of “underrepresented communities” on their boards, beginning in 2021. See Part I, Chapter 3F.

highlights of this release

- **Part I, Chapter 2.A:** The Delaware Court of Chancery has ruled that company management cannot unilaterally withhold proprietary information from board members, even if it believes their interests are adverse to the company.
- **Part I Chapter 3.F:** California will require public companies headquartered in that state to include members of “underrepresented communities” on their boards, beginning in 2021.
- **Part II, Chapter 4.A:** Trial courts have vacated recent rule changes by the Department of Labor narrowing definitions of joint employer.
- **Part II, Chapter 4.E:** President Trump has issued an Executive Order seeking to prevent training in “divisive concepts” by federal agencies and contractors.
- **Part II, Chapter 4.F:** Trial courts have vacated recent rule changes by the NLRB narrowing definitions of joint employer.
