- **Asbestos Demolitions and Renovations Fees:** The Yolo Solano Air Quality Management District provides a schedule of fees for asbestos demolition and renovation activities in Rule 4.3. The agency recently made a cost recovery fee adjustment impacting this rule effective July 1, 2020. The adjustment revised the fee that an owner or operator must pay for each facility survey submitted to the District for an asbestos demolition or renovation.

- A newly released Fire and Smoke Map page is available from the Yolo Solano Air Quality Management District. This resource is a collaboration between the U.S. Forest Service and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and is aimed at providing the public with additional information on levels of particle pollution (PM2.5) in the air, particularly during wildfires. This site incorporates data collected by air sensors into the permanent monitoring systems maintained by various federal and state agencies and special districts.
