new & noteworthy

- **Addition of VOC Emissions Requirements for Mobile Transport Tanks:** Coverage of requirements related to the storage and transfer of volatile organic compounds (VOC) has been expanded with the addition of Rule 61.2, Transfer of Organic Compounds into Mobile Transport Tanks. The rule applies to the transfer of VOC into mobile transport tanks having a capacity of 550 gallons or greater at three types of facilities: bulk terminals, bulk plants, and intermediate refuelers. The rule is also applicable to transferring other liquid compounds into any mobile transport tank that previously contained gasoline.

This rule has been added to **Air Quality Management in San Diego County Air Pollution Control District, Rulebook B, Organic Compounds.**

highlights of this release

- **Air Quality Management in SDAPCD, Rulebook B: Organic Compounds,** was expanded to include Rule 61.2, Transfer of Organic Compounds into Mobile Transport Tanks.

did you know?

- **Compliance Information Available On-Line:** The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District's Compliance Division has developed information on specific types of business operations to help ensure that all facilities comply with applicable regulations and permit conditions. Currently, information is available for gasoline stations, painting operations, asbestos renovation and demolition operations, mobile sources, portable equipment, stationary diesel engines, methane emissions from landfills, and open burning.
