new & noteworthy

- **Advanced Clean Trucks Regulation:** On March 26, 2020, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) adopted a rulemaking with two new regulatory components related to vehicle emissions (CRNR 2021, No. 13-z). First, it requires manufacturers to sell Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEVs) as an increasing percentage of annual truck sales in California. Second, it requires one-time reporting of information from large organizations including retailers, manufacturers, and government agencies about their medium- and heavy-duty vehicle fleet and requires that certain records be kept.

This change adds the fleet reporting and recordkeeping provisions to **Air Quality Management SDAPCD, Rulebook A, General Requirements**.

highlights of this release

- **Air Quality Management in SDAPCD, Rulebook B, Organic Compounds**, was expanded to include Rule 61.2, Transfer of Organic Compounds into Mobile Transport Tanks.

did you know?

- **Compliance Information Available On-Line:** The San Diego County Air Pollution Control District's Compliance Division has developed information on specific types of business operations to help ensure that all facilities comply with applicable regulations and permit conditions. Currently, information is available for gasoline stations, painting operations, asbestos renovation and demolition operations, mobile sources, portable equipment, stationary diesel engines, methane emissions from landfills, and open burning.
