



## Environmental Auditing: Air Quality Management in Yolo Solano

### new & noteworthy

- **Advanced Clean Trucks Regulation:** On March 26, 2020, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) adopted a rulemaking with two new regulatory components related to vehicle emissions (CRNR 2021, No. 13-z). First, it requires manufacturers to sell Zero Emission Vehicles (ZEVs) as an increasing percentage of annual truck sales in California. Second, it requires one-time reporting of information from large organizations including retailers, manufacturers, and government agencies about their medium- and heavy-duty vehicle fleet and requires that certain records be kept.

This change adds the fleet reporting and recordkeeping provisions to **Air Quality Management in YSAQMD, Rulebook A, General Requirements**.

### did you know?

- **Spare the Air:** The Sacramento region's annual Spare the Air season has started and will continue through October 31. The region includes the Sacramento Metropolitan, El Dorado, Feather River, Placer and Yolo-Solano Air Districts. During this time, a Spare the Air alert will be issued when the Air Quality Index (AQI) for ground-level ozone is forecast to be 126 or above. Residents in the region are encouraged to continue to telework, take transit, drive a hybrid or electric vehicle, or consider active transportation options, such as walking, biking, or riding a scooter when possible, to help continue to improve air quality in the region.
